CHILDREN'S CURRICULUM

All kindergarten and elementary-aged students are required to take beginner and intermediate drawing classes as a prerequisite to some other classes. Skills learned in these foundation classes are essential to the Artsplace program. Our children's drawing curriculum is as follows:

- Beginner: Includes contour line, flat color, texture, mirror image, negative space and volume drawing. Media are Flair pens and markers.
- Intermediate: Reinforces beginner concepts with more detailed projects including some shading and volume drawing. Students can repeat Intermediate classes multiple times as this will reinforce drawing skills. Lessons and subjects vary with each session. (Prerequisite: Beginner)
- Advanced: Includes perspective and dimensional drawing, and introduces different media. (Prerequisite: Intermediate)




